This comprehensive two-day program is created specifically for those with a role in clinical education and training and who wish to enhance their teaching skills in simulation-based education.

In the Simulation Course you will cover:

- Technical set-up of simulators
- Education theory and the simulation cycle
- Identify and write learning objectives for clinical skills or scenario-based training appropriate to their clinical setting
- Scenario design: design a basic clinical scenario clearly aligned with the learning objectives
- Use a high technology simulator, task trainers or manikins to create realistic learning opportunities
- Scenario scripting
- Debriefing: use basic debriefing skills to contribute to simulation learning
- Practical moulage workshop

TRAIN-THE-TRAINER OSCE COURSE & WORKSHOP (2-DAY COURSE):

The main purpose of this course is to help you prepare and maintain the skills required to examine proficiently in OSCEs. You will gain a greater understanding of theory behind OSCEs, and also familiarize yourself with the process and some of the practical issues required in being an OSCE examiner. Ultimately our aim is to help improve consistency of examiners for reliable and fair examination of all candidates.

In the OSCE Course you will cover:

- Understanding typical simulation-based education strategies to support OSCE rehearsal
- Writing a formative OSCE Scenario in line with Evidence Based Criteria
- Tools and techniques for simulating OSCE assessments
- Evaluation of performance a constructive feedback
- Hints and tips to successfully perform an OSCE assessment
